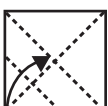

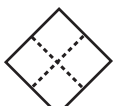
With the blank side up, fold from corner to corner, making a triangle.



Fold one corner to the center of the square, where the two diagonal creases meet.



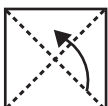
Turn your paper over so the folds are on the table.



Fold and unfold the square in half, horizontally.



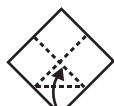
Open up the paper (back facing up) and fold from corner to corner in the opposite direction.



Repeat this with the other three corners.



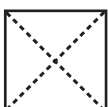
Fold the corner to the center of the square where the creases meet.

Repeat this with the other three corners. Your square will be even smaller now.

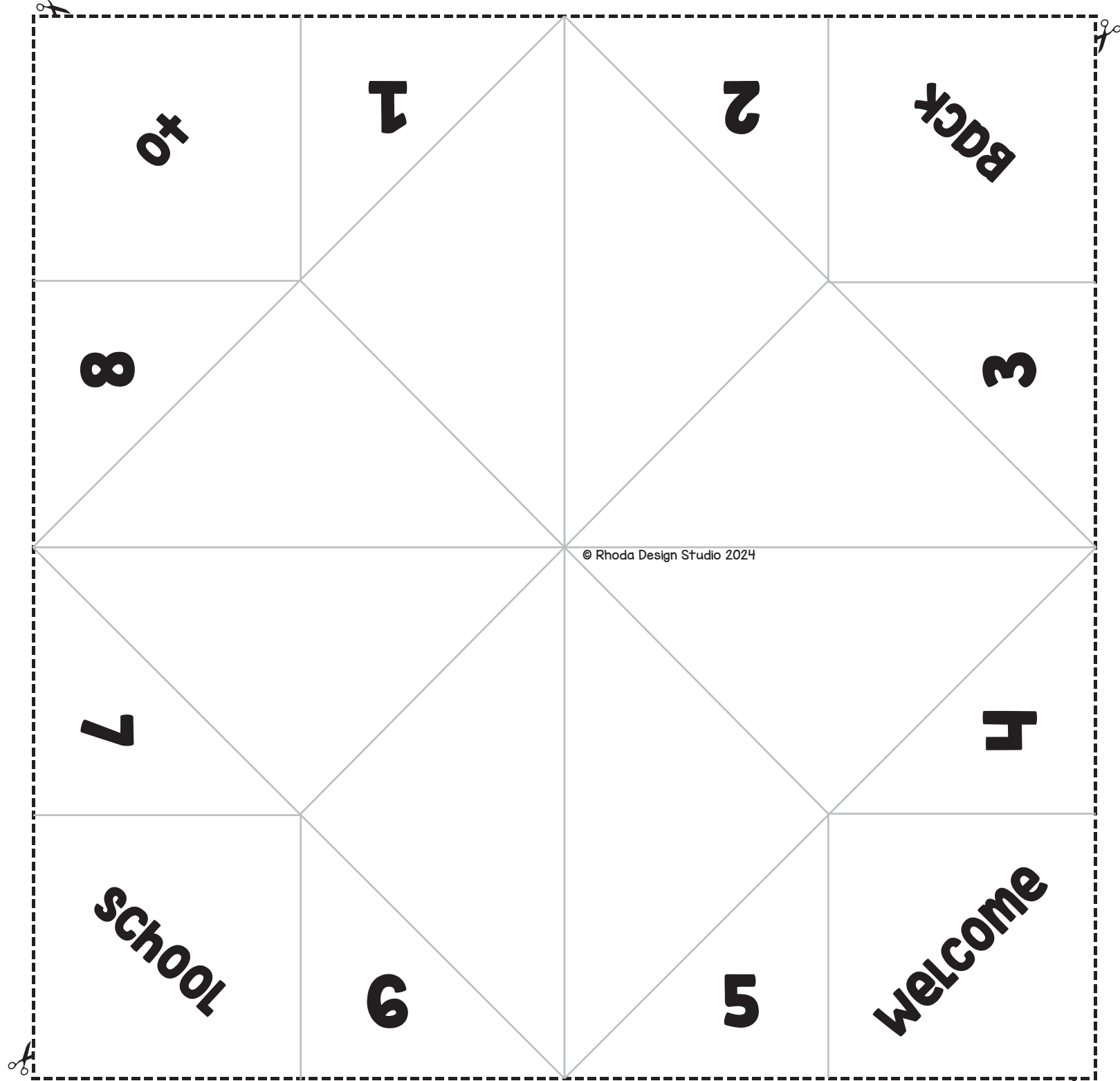


You will have creases that look like this. Turn it over & slide your fingers under the flaps. Push the outer corners to the middle.
